A prize-winning professor, she teaches classes in evidence, historical methods, humanistic inquiry, and American history. Much of her scholarship explores absences and asymmetries in the historical record, with a particular emphasis on the history and technology of evidence. Sociology 1171: Crime and Order in the American City
Semester: Fall
Offered: 2019

Issues about crime and social order have animated debates about cities for over a century. After reviewing classic approaches to the study of the American city, we will evaluate contemporary arguments on central themes such as the "broken-windows" theory of crime, the uses of public space, racial segregation and inequality, immigration, gentrification, the crime decline, and mass incarceration. Students will conduct neighborhood observations as one of the requirements.

This seminar examines crime and criminalization across the life course. Social processes and content are emphasized. Key themes include the long-term study of continuity and change; trajectories, transitions, and turning points; cohort

WELCOME TO THE CARPENTER LAB WEBSITE


The Carpenter Lab is based at the [Broad Institute of MIT and Harvard](#) in Cambridge, Massachusetts, USA. Our research group develops advanced methods and software tools to quantify and mine the rich information present in cellular images to yield biological discoveries.

We are passionate about developing computational techniques that accelerate the discovery of new medicines, and we work across all disease areas, from cancer and psychiatric disease to rare disorders and infectious disease.

Our laboratory is best known for our popular open source software [CellProfiler](#) and [CellProfiler Analyst](#), and are leading community efforts to bring deep learning to biologists, for segmentation and classification.
